What Triads Are Not:

- Sin-Management Groups (the worst form of "Accountability Groups")
 - Instead, Triads emphasize the future in seeking health
- Life-Coaching Groups
 - Instead, Triads seek the will of God in someone's life
- Book Clubs
 - Instead, Triads use content only to Encourage, Discern, and Intercede


A Triad is made up of three people at LWF who seek to encourage, discern, and intercede in each other's lives.

The goal is to become friends who meet weekly to help each other be apprentices of Jesus: learning to live with Him, become like Him, and walk in His ways. This is done in the power of the Holy Spirit, who is the transformative presence of Jesus in us.




To serve one another at this level of detail simply isn't possible in our current group setting.

Vision: Discern God's will for future growth for each member of the triad.




What about LWF Groups?

 - To accomodate vacations for participants


